When we use addition, we are adding one lot to another.

For example,

$3 + 2$ is the same as $2 + 3$



Use your fingers to add the numbers together and circle the correct answer.

$$5 + 5 =$$

$$2 + 3 \text{ is the same as } 3 + 2 =$$

$$4 + 3 \text{ is the same as } 3 + 4 =$$

$$4 + 5 \text{ is the same as } 5 + 4 =$$

Any number added to another is the same in reverse.
